



PLAY WITH: The 2 full alphabets (one pink, one blue) and the 7 stars.

*FIRST read the Toutilix basic principles!

OBJECT: Quickly find words with and without certain letters.

SET UP: Shuffle the cards and deal them out evenly. Each player forms a face-down draw pile.

HOW TO PLAY: The youngest starts. Quickly flip over your top card (facing away from you so everyone sees it at the same time) and place it face up in the middle of the table. The next player turns over a 2nd card and the following player turns over a 3rd card. With 2 players, the 1st player turns over the 3rd card.

You must always have 3 stacks of cards, regardless of the number of players.

MINI OR MAXI OPTIONS: Make things easier by forming just TWO stacks of cards, or harder by forming FOUR stacks of cards!

The first player who says a word that contains **the BLUE letters but not the PINK letters** wins all the cards! They put those cards into a face-up pile to form their points. Then play again, starting a new pile, with the next players taking turns to form new piles.

If no one has any ideas after 10 seconds, if there is a tie, or if a mistake is made: The next player plays a card on top of whichever card they want.

If there are only PINK letters, you have to find a word that doesn't contain any of those letters!

If there are two identical letters, the first one to say, "TOUTILIX!" wins all the cards in the piles and plays again.

If there is a star, the first player to slap the table wins all the cards in the piles and plays again.

Play continues as long as ALL the players have cards to play.

THE WINNER is the one with the most cards.
